Zoning, Preservation, and Development Committee

- 2521 12th St NW (RF-1) – Oluseyi Ademiluyi (1B-06) Jennifer Bristol – BZA 19546 Hearing Date 9/6/17

The Applicant asks under 11 DCMR Subtitle X, Chapter 9, for special exceptions under Subtitle E § 5201 from the rear yard requirements of Subtitle E § 205.4, under Subtitle E § 5203.3 from the roof top architectural element requirements of Subtitle E § 206.1(a), and from the penthouse requirements of Subtitle C § 1500.4, to construct a rear addition to an existing one-family dwelling in the RF-1 Zone at premises 2521 12th Street N.W. (Square 2865, Lot 140).

Commissioner Bristol moved that the ANC1B support the special exceptions for the roof top element requirements, the penthouse requirements and oppose the special exception from the rear yard requirements, past the 10ft rule, to permit construction of a rear addition to an existing one-family dwelling converting into a two-unit flat in the RF-1 Zone at 2521 12th St NW
