- **DDOT Occupancy Permit #10684462/New Sidewalk Café Enclosed/ Service Bar 926 U Street NW.** Service Bar is requesting a 32' wide by 6' deep enclosed sidewalk café on the south side of U Street between Vermont Ave and 9<sup>th</sup> Street  
Committee Recommendation: Recommend Full ANC Support  
Commissioner Cacoza moved to support requests  
**Motion passed with unanimous consent**
- **DDOT Occupancy Permit # 10683669/New Sidewalk Café Un-Enclosed/ Kiss LLC 637 T Street NW.** Kiss is requesting an 88' wide by 40' deep un-enclosed sidewalk café. This is across two sidewalk cafes, one on Florida Avenue, one on T Street  
Committee Recommendation: recommend Full ANC support under the condition that the cafe space on Florida Avenue is reduced from 8 feet wide to 4 feet wide.
