Transportation Committee

- DDOT Construction Permit #318436 / Grimke School Redevelopment / 1923 Vermont Ave NW

The Committee recommends that the ANC support the permit with the condition that – in accordance with the Duke Plan to honor the area’s historic and cultural significance -- DDOT allow and the developers use brick/granite sidewalks and cohesive streetlights as currently present on Vermont Ave between U St and T St, on the Vermont Avenue face; and that fixtures (bike racks, streetlights) are designed to enhance the historic and cultural use of the building.
