Information Session

- Short Term Family Housing Update
 - Plan to end homelessness by making it rare, brief, and non-recurring
 - DC has reduced homelessness by 40%
 - Closed DC Gen and opened new short-term family housing program in 4, 7 and 8
 - Ward one site will be for 35 families – Clifton and 14th ST (parking lot of Rita Bright)
 - 24/7 security
 - Dedicated play and common space
 - Wrap around services
 - 15 permanent supportive housing (back), 35 short term family housing (front), with central courtyard
 - Building has conditional approval from the Commission of Fine Arts and is now presenting to community and DHS before second approval
 - Completion date: 2020, breaking ground in May 2019
